

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This cleaner is used for cleaning, sanitizing, disinfecting and deodorizing. It is suitable for use in homes, schools, hospitals, restaurants, hotels, and other public places. It is also used for cleaning and sanitizing food processing equipment and other food contact surfaces. It is a powerful disinfectant and deodorizer. It is safe for use on most surfaces.

CLEANING DIRECTIONS

For general cleaning, use up to 4 oz. per gallon of water. For heavy cleaning, use up to 8 oz. per gallon of water. For sanitizing, use up to 4 oz. per gallon of water. For disinfecting, use up to 8 oz. per gallon of water. For deodorizing, use up to 4 oz. per gallon of water. For severe cleaning, use up to 16 oz. per gallon of water. For sanitizing, use up to 4 oz. per gallon of water. For disinfecting, use up to 8 oz. per gallon of water. For deodorizing, use up to 4 oz. per gallon of water. **SEE CLEANING CHART.**

DISINFECTING DIRECTIONS

Apply to surfaces to be disinfected. Allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes. Rinse with clean water. For use on floors, mop with solution. For use on walls, spray with solution. For use on ceilings, spray with solution. For use on furniture, wipe with solution. For use on linens, wash with solution. For use on dishes, wash with solution. For use on cutlery, wash with solution. For use on glassware, wash with solution. For use on metalware, wash with solution. For use on plasticware, wash with solution. For use on paperware, wash with solution. For use on fabricware, wash with solution. For use on leatherware, wash with solution. For use on woodware, wash with solution. DANGER-Corrosive KEEP OUT OF REACH
OF CHILDREN

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. If persistent convulsions may be controlled by the cautious injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Prohibitions - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL Triple rinse or equivalent and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
