

DIRECTIONS

Cleaning —

For light duty cleaning, such as wood-work and walls, use 2 oz. cleaner for each gallon of water. For heavy duty cleaning and damp mopping of waxed floors, use 4 oz. cleaner for each gallon water.

To remove old wax, use 1 pint (2 cups) cleaner for each gallon water and allow solution to "work" before scrubbing.

DISINFECTING OF INANIMATE OBJECTS

Recommended for hotels, motels, office schools.

First clean surface with solution of 2 oz. per gallon of water.

Next apply a fresh solution of 2 oz. per gallon of water and allow contact for 5 minutes.
