FORMULA A

INSECTICIDE For Food Processing Plants

DO NOT STORE IN SUNLIGHT

ALWAYS KEEP DRUM CLOSED

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:
100% Petroleum Distillates, Piperonyl Butoxide*,
Pyrethrins.
*Consists of (ether and related) compounds
(Butylcarbityl, 6-propylpiperonyl)

DIRECTIONS

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND WASPS

Spray FORMULA A freely in closed room until filled with mist. Direct spray toward ceiling. Leave room closed 10 to 15 minutes. Sweep dead insects; then open windows.

TO KILL THE ACCESSIBLE STAGES OF WEEVIL AND GRAIN MOTHS

Spray liberally and thoroughly to ceilings, walls, floors, beams, pipes, joists, partitions, and all interior surfaces of empty bins, chutes, elevator shafts, and storage rooms. Pay particular attention to cracks, crevices, and other hiding places.

TO KILL ANTS

Spray generously, paying particular attention to runways, window sills, and door treads where ants enter the premises.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH

Spray generously around sinks, baseboards, refrigerator, forcing liquid in all cracks and crevices.

REPEAT ALL DIRECTIONS WHEN NECESSARY • DO NOT SPRAY NEAR OPEN FIRE

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed.
