CAUTION

Avoid excessive inhalation of spray mist.

Avoid direct spraying of foods and cooking utensils.

Use Fly-Nix Aerosols as a space-spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

Do not spray near or toward an open flame.

Remove birds, fish and pets from room being sprayed.

Do not set dispenser on stove or radiator.

Do not store where temperature will exceed 110° F. such as window sills or direct sunlight.

Do not puncture this container or release contents except through spray nozzle.

Hold dispenser three feet away from object being sprayed to avoid possible staining.

How to Use

FLY-NIX®

Remove safety cap. Do not turn can upside down. Have the spout turned away from you. Release the spray by pressing valve.

For Roaches, Waterbugs, Ants, Silverfish: Spray insects and their hiding places thoroughly, such as cracks, crevices behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, shelves, door frames and ant trails.

For Flies, Mosquitoes and small flying insects: Close up room and spray 5 or 6 seconds for the average size room (10' x 10' x 10') walking about the room to spread mist.

INDOORS:
TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, FLYING MOTHS AND SIMILAR FLYING INSECTS: Close all doors and windows and direct spray into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room about 1000 cubic feet. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying.
TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, ANTS AND CERTAIN OTHER CRAWLING INSECTS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails over window sills and other locations. Avoid direct spraying of foods.
TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS, CARPET-BEETLES: Thoroughly spray clothing and other woolsens, paying particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every 30 days unless the articles are stored in a mothtight container.
TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstands, baseboards, floor boards, and wall frequently.
FOR HOUSE PLANTS: Spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage for such plants as English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary.

OUTDOORS:
For bugs on such plants as Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses, and Snapdragon. Also for bugs on Evergreen and small ornamental trees, shrubs and vines. When sprayed directly on insects this spray kills sucking insects such as Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Thrips (exposed) and Lace Bugs. Kills chewing insects such as Caterpillars, Mexican Bean Beetles, climbing cutworms and Japanese Beetles.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray rows on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when garden temperature exceeds 90° F.

CAUTION

Cover exposed food and utensils; this product can be used around foodstuffs and utensils if they are protected from direct contact during spraying. Do not spray on plastics or asphalt tile. Keep out of reach of children.
