# TOMATO DUST

FOR CONTROL OF  
EARLY & LATE BLIGHT

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:  
Tri-basic Copper Sulphate ..... 13.2%  
Copper as metallic 7.0%  
INERT INGREDIENTS ..... 86.8%  
Total ..... 100.0%

## — DIRECTIONS —

Dust the plants in the seed bed lightly and uniformly at weekly intervals. After transplanting and after the first clusters of the fruit have formed, dust lightly at two-week intervals, covering both sides of the foliage. Apply 30 to 40 lbs. per acre per dusting. If used as a spray, mix thoroughly 6 oz. of TOMATO DUST with each gallon of water and follow the schedule for dusting.

## — CAUTION —

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of the dust or spray mist. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs. The fruit from treated plants should be washed before eating. Do not reuse the container; dispose of it safely.
