DIRECTIONS

For control of Mexican Bean beetle, bean leaf hopper, spider mites and aphids on beans (Lima, Green, Snap) mix as directed and spray thoroughly, (1 - 1 1/2 Tablespoons in 1 gallon of water). Do not spray within 3 days of harvest.

For control of Cabbage worms, aphids on Cabbage, and Kale mix 1 - 1-1/2 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water and spray thoroughly. Do not spray within 14 days of harvest.

For control of Pickleworm, Cucumber beetles and Aphids on Cucumbers spray as directed. Do not spray within 1 day of harvest.

For control of Tomato horn ... , aphids, leaf hoppers, and spider mites spray as directed. Do not spray within 1 day of harvest.

For control of Japanese beetles on Ornamentals, spray foliage with 1 - 1-1/2 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water when adult beetles are first noted. Repeat every 5 - 7 days as necessary.

Liquid Baricide is a multi-purpose concentrated insecticide spray

Back Panel con't.

For vegetables, roses, flowers, ornamentals mix 1 - 1-1/2 tablespoons of liquid baricide in 1 gallon of water. Application can be made with any type garden sprayer. Start spray applications when pests appear or when damage is noted, repeat every 7 - 10 days or as needed for adequate control. For scale insects mix 2 - 3 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water, spray woody parts of the plants and stems until run-off occurs.

If a fungicide is needed to control fungi and plant diseases, liquid baricide may be added to Spray Powder Zinc, Ferbam, or Maneb. Consult directions on label for mixing directions.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. In case of contact, wash with soap and water. For eyes get medical attention. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use on Pets or animals. Do not store near feed or foodstuffs. Combustible mixture, keep away from open flames.
