

Nursery Care. To protect baby. clean crib, bathinette, toys with tablespoon Hexol per qt. water. Pour a little Hexol in diaper pail to make sanitary and do away with odor When haby throws up out a little Hard'



For a Clean Smelling Sanitary Bathroom

Germicidal solution to disinfect: tablespoon Hexol per quart warm water in wash basin. Dip cloth or sponge — wipe over fixtures to quickly clean, make sanitary. Pour a little Hexol in toilet to deodorize.

FOR THE MEDICINE CABINET

Feminine Hygiene. Teaspoon Hexol per qt. warm water for cleansing, soothing douche. Effective. gentle--non-antiseptic for this use. Caution: do not use more often than twice weekly unless directed by physician.

Hot Tired Feet. Mix a little Hexol in pan of warm water. Put feet in, move them about for quick, comforting relief. For the temporary relief of itching and discomfort due to athlete's foot, apply Hexol to irritated places. Common types quickly clear up.

Minor Cuts - Bruises. Clean skin, then apply loose dressing kept damp with healing Hexol. Ca in: in case of deep or puncture wounds or serious burns, consult physician. If redness, irritation, swelling, or pain persists or increases or if infection occurs discontinue use and consult physician.

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In the Bath. A little Hexol added to the bath water is cleansing.
