DIRECTIONS

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING — Clean thoroughly with a good detergent, then apply PHENE BACTERICIDE, diluted one ounce to a gallon of water, so as to wet all thoroughly and allow to remain in contact for five minutes

FOR DISINFECTING floors, lavatories, bathrooms, shower rooms, toilets, urinals, sinks, etc. thoroughly with a good detergent. Apply WESCO-PHENE BACTERICIDE, diluted one a gallon of water, so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly and allow to remain in contact minutes.
