CAUTION

Never spray directly on plastics. Avoid contamination of feed and feedstuff. Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of aerosol mist. Do not store at temperatures over 150°F. Do not puncture can or throw it into fire.

HOW TO OPERATE

This dispenser is sealed for storage and shipping purposes. To break seal and make ready to use, press down firmly on the plastic button until a spray is obtained.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

If possible close space to be treated. Release three feet from any surface, holding the dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser about while spraying aids dispersion. Disperse only for time indicated. USE SPARINGLY. Seven seconds spraying time is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10'x10'x10'). Not necessary to spray directly on insects but merely release in the air since the aerosol will disperse throughout the enclosed space. Temporarily effective in sheltered outdoor area.
