

DIRECTIONS

For cleaning, deodorizing and disinfecting walls, floors, restroom fixtures, shower rooms, animal kennels, bird cages, animal runs, garbage cans: thoroughly wet and wash surfaces with a solution containing 2 ounces BACTISOL per gallon of water.

For disinfecting food and eating equipment: Use 2 ounces BACTISOL per gallon of water and follow with rinse of clean potable water.

To sanitize precleaned food processing equipment and food contact items, use 2.8 ounces BACTISOL per 5 gallon of water (200 ppm of active quaternary). At this level, no potable water rinse is required.

To kill athlete's foot fungi (*T. interdigitale*): After cleaning locker and shower room floors, swimming pool walks, thoroughly wet and wash floors with solution containing 2 ounces BACTISOL per gallon of water.

Do not mix with other cleaning compounds. This product is incompatible with soaps and most detergents.

DANGER - Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID - In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
