

(For plastic containers)

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

- c. The "Active Ingredients" and "Inert Ingredient" headings must be aligned to the same margin.

- e. Revise the "Use Directions" to read:

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- f. Include a 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section.

- g. On the side panel, revise the statement:

. . . hazard of cross-infection

to read:

. . . hazard of cross-contamination.

- h. Delete the word "milk" from the Statement of Practical Treatment.

- i. Revise "a pre-cleaning step is recommended" to read "a pre-cleaning step is required."


