#### **USE DIRECTIONS**

##### **DISINFECTION**

For disinfection of hard surfaces, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/2 ounce per gallon. Apply to surface and allow to remain for 10 minutes. Rinse with clean water. For disinfection of linens, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/2 ounce per gallon. Wash linens in hot water with detergent. Rinse with clean water. For disinfection of laundry, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/2 ounce per gallon. Wash laundry in hot water with detergent. Rinse with clean water.

##### **SANITIZATION**

For sanitization of hard surfaces, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/4 ounce per gallon. Apply to surface and allow to remain for 5 minutes. Rinse with clean water. For sanitization of linens, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/4 ounce per gallon. Wash linens in hot water with detergent. Rinse with clean water. For sanitization of laundry, dilute MEGASOL 256 with water to a concentration of 1/4 ounce per gallon. Wash laundry in hot water with detergent. Rinse with clean water.

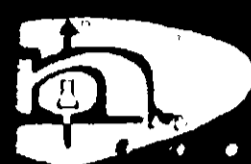

MEGASOL 256 is a concentrated, non-phosphate detergent, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, and deodorizer. It is specifically designed for Institutional use such as Hospitals, Nursing Homes, and Schools where housekeeping will be of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross-infections from environmental surfaces.

MEGASOL 256 is for use on floors, walls, and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Hotels, Public Areas, Industrial Areas, and Institutions. It is excellent for Operating Rooms, Rest Rooms, Nurseries, and Food Service Areas.

When used as directed, MEGASOL 256 is effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. MEGASOL 256 is also effective against the pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton interdigitale.

If used for sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment or food contact items, limit the active quaternaries to 200 ppm. At this level, NO POTABLE WATER RINSE IS REQUIRED.

#### DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food.

#### FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.
