PINOLEUM is a pine-type cleaner which provides effective cleaning and deodorizing for those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage pails, sink tops, and bathroom areas, including toilet bowls and urinals, which are prone to odors caused by the growth of some microorganisms. As a cleaner, PINOLEUM will remove greasy dirt and film from floors, walls, table tops, and similar hard surfaces. Removes pencil, ink, and crayon from hard, non-porous surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PINOLEUM has been designed for institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance such as nursing homes, hotels, schools, and office buildings. PINOLEUM is formulated with a pine oil and soap combination to clean and deodorize, leaving a pleasant scent of pine. PINOLEUM is a limited disinfectant for killing odor causing bacteria.

GENERAL CLEANING - PINOLEUM may be used as a general cleaner to clean areas where the fresh smell of pine is desired. Use 4 ounces PINOLEUM per gallon of water. Apply this solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer to floors, walls, counters, and similar surfaces. Scrub, then wipe up excess solution and let air dry. No rinsing is required.

TO CLEAN TOILET AND URINAL BOWLS - Preclean the bowl, flush, and add 4 ounces PINOLEUM directly to the bowl water. Scrub the bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand a few minutes and flush.

FOR HEAVILY SOILED AREAS - and for pencil, ink, or crayon marks use PINOLEUM at full strength. Immediately follow with a water rinse.
