2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 1799-11."
 - b. For the label size submitted, the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL heading and the Child Hazard Warning "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" would require a 12 point type size minimum and the signal word DANGER (front panel only) would require an 18 point type size minimum when final labels are printed.
 - c. The statement "FOR SALE FOR USE AND STORAGE BY MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL ONLY" must be at least the same type size as the "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" statement (front panel) when final labels are printed.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN DANGER

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.
