Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

Directions for Use

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LONZA FORMULATION 70-10 is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-fungicide-virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply **LONZA FORMULATION 70-10** to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection - To disinfect hard non-porous surfaces, add 1/2 oz per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use-level **LONZA FORMULATION 70-10** is also virucidal and fungicidal.

Sanitizing - To sanitize porous or non-porous, non-food contact surfaces, add 1/4 oz per gallon of water.

1/2 oz per gallon use-level. The broad spectrum activity of **LONZA FORMULATION 70-10** has been demonstrated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following by the AOAC Use-Dilution Test:

Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise areas, dressing rooms, etc.

Mildewstat Performance: At 1/2 oz per gallon **LONZA FORMULATION 70-10** will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance:

At 1/2 oz per gallon use-level **LONZA FORMULATION 70-10** was evaluated in the presence of 10% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis); Vaccinia (representative of the pox viruses); and Influenza A₁ (the Hong Kong flu virus) on inanimate environmental surfaces.


