# WETTABLE DUSTING SULPHUR

## ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Sulphur .....	93%
INERT INGREDIENTS .....	7%
TOTAL ..	100.00%

**CAUTION. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**

**PRECAUTION:** Do not apply Sulphur when temperature is over 95 degrees as it may burn foliage. Do not apply to foliage within one week after spraying foliage with oil emulsion type spray. Do not apply any oil emulsion spray to foliage sprayed or dusted with sulphur within 30 days.

**DIRECTIONS:** Recommended for control of the following Black Spot on roses, Powdery Mildew on roses, chrysanthemums, Calendula, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Phlox, Sweet Peas, Lilacs, Beans, Peas and Peaches; Leaf Spots on Phlox and Hollyhocks, Rust on Chrysanthemums, Snapdragons, Carnations, Asparagus and Beans; Common Red Spider, Mites on Beans, Cotton, Evergreens, Figs, Plums, and Thrips, Citrus Red Spider and Two spotted Mite on citrus fruits.

**TO MIX:** Put 4 Tablespoons of Sulphur and approximately the same amount of water together and mix into a thick paste, then slowly add water until a gallon is added, stirring constantly so that thorough mixture will result. Apply with ordinary sprayer. Keep well stirred at all times.

**THE TIME** to apply is when the air is still, preferably early morning or late afternoon. Apply when insects threaten and every few days until eliminated. Cover all leaves, stems, and blossoms on both upper and lower surfaces.
