POISON

Danger:

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin! Rapidly absorbed through skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for parathion protection.

Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

FIRST AID TREATMENT—**CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY**

If operators handling or working with Parathion develop symptoms of headache, blurred vision, weakness, nausea, cramps, diarrhea, or discomfort in the chest.

ATROPINE (1 100 gr. tablet) is antidotal. Keep an emergency supply on hand.

Until the physician arrives, follow the first aid treatments given here.

INTERNAL—If swallowed, give one tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Administer milk or water freely. Have patient lie down, keep warm and quiet. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious patient.

INHALATION—Remove patient from contaminated atmosphere.

SKIN—If skin is contaminated, immediately wash thoroughly with soap and water. Flush skin with water for at least 15 minutes. If clothing is also contaminated, remove immediately and follow washing instructions given above.

EYES—If eyes are contaminated, immediately flush with water for at least 15 minutes.

If symptoms include blurred vision or pinpoint pupils, don't wait for doctor to arrive, but give ATROPINE (2 tablets) at once.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PHYSICIANS

ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL. Do not give morphine. Give atropine grains 1/60 to grains 1/30 (1 or 2 mg.) every hour until pupils dilate. Clear chest by postural drainage. Give artificial respiration if patient becomes comatose.

IMPORTANT**DO NOT RE-USE CONTAINER**

THESE PROCEDURES SHOULD BE FOLLOWED WHEN THIS CONTAINER IS COMPLETELY EMPTIED:

DECONTAMINATION

1—**Glass Container:** Break the container and bury the pieces at least 18 inches deep in an isolated location away from water supplies.

2—**Metal Containers:** Pour the following mixture into the empty container:

5-gal drums—2 quarts water, 1/2 cup caustic soda (household lye), 2 tablespoons detergent.

30 gal drums—3 gallons water, 1/2 pound caustic soda (household lye), 1/2 cup detergent.

55 gal drums—5 gallons water, 2 pounds caustic soda (household lye), 1 cup detergent.

Rotate container carefully until all inner surfaces are thoroughly wet. Bury the rinse solution at least 18 inches deep in an isolated area away from water supplies.

CAUTION: Handle caustic soda (household lye) with extreme care. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Read and carefully follow the precautions on the package.

DISPOSAL OF 5-GALLON AND 30 GALLON CONTAINERS:

Punch holes in the top and bottom of the container, crush the container and bury.
