NET WEIGHT 5 GALLONS

On small trees (no larger than 4 inches in diameter), do not spray higher than 18 inches from ground.

Lips Beetle and Southern Pine Beetle. Mix 1 gallon Lindane in 55 gallons of water and spray all bark to the point of run-off.

NOTE - DO NOT SPRAY AFTER RAIN WHEN BARK IS WET.

LAWN INSECTS -- Fall Armyworm, Sod Webworm and Mole Crickets. Mix 1/2 pint of Lindane in 10 gallons of water to cover 1000 square feet of lawn. Do not increase the rates as injury to grass may occur.

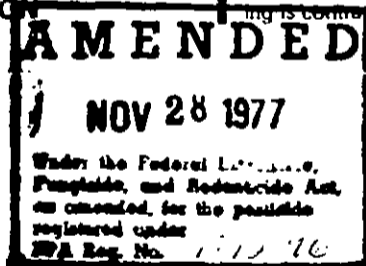

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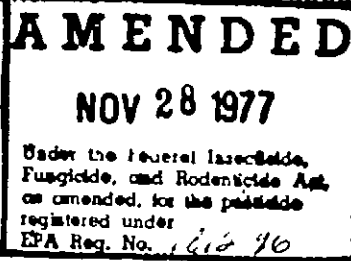
