Insect	Lbs. 50 W Sevin To 100 Gals. Water	Where and When To Apply
Green June Beetle	2 Lbs.	When adults appear on fruit.
Japanese Beetle	2 Lbs.	When beetles appear. Repeat in 10-14 days if needed.
Leaf Rollers	2 Lbs.	When insects become active.
Oriental Fruit Moth	2 Lbs.	3 times at 10-day intervals beginning at shuck split and at six and 3 weeks before harvest.
Plum Curculio	2 Lbs.	When application is needed close to harvest
Scales, Forbes, San Jose, Walnut and White Peach	1 Lb.	When crawlers are active.
Scales, European fruit Licanium Terrapin and Cottony Peach	n, 2 Lbs.	At completion of hatching. A second application may be made if infestation persists.
Stink Bugs	2 Lbs.	Petal Fall and 2-3 times 10 days apart.
