DIRECTION

COTTON: For the control of boll weevil, bollworm, thrips, fleahopper rapid plant bug, leafworm, and grasshopper.

Apply at the rate of 15 to 25 pounds per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of hand picking.

WARNING: Hazardous by Swallowing, Inhalation, or Skin Contact! Rapidly absorbed through skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe dust or spray mist.
