Ants are attracted to the bait in Volcano Ant Baits. The bait food is carried back to the nest to kill the queen and destroy the entire colony.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Break Volcano Ant Baits apart from the plastic frame before placement.

Place baits by ant trails or close to areas where ants are present. Do not place baits on food preparation surfaces when food is being handled or on utensils that are used for food preparation. Also place adjacent to walls, electrical lines, potted plants, waste receptacles, sensitive electronic equipment, inside drop ceilings and wall voids or any where ant problems occur. To apply baits to vertical surfaces use the enclosed stickers.

Do not use residual sprays with or near Volcano Ant Baits.

Ants will begin to die in 24 hours - significant population reduction can be expected in about a week

### FOR EFFECTIVE CONTROL

Use 3 to 4 baits for the average size room. Use 6 to 8 baits for heavy infestations.

Bait stations are designed to be visually inspected with a flashlight. This allows for monitoring and timely replacement. Replacement is recommended after 3 months or when bait is almost entirely consumed (do not risk loss of control by allowing complete consumption).

Volcano Ant Baits are packaged in a Child Resistant Container.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children.

**DISPOSAL:** Wrap container and put in trash collection.

### ADDITIONAL LISTED USE SITES FOR VOLCANO ANT BAITS

**Greenhouse (Commercial), Household:** Closets, basements, attics, recreation rooms, kitchens, bathrooms, dining rooms, pantry and food storage shelving.

**Transportation Facilities:** Trucks and trailers, containerized units, railroad cars, recreational vehicles, shipping containers.
