DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Break Volcano Ant Baits apart from the plastic frame before placement.

Place baits by ant trails or close to areas where ants are present. Do not place baits on food preparation surfaces when food is being handled or on utensils that are used for food preparation. Also place adjacent to walls, electrical lines, potted plants, waste receptacles, sensitive electronic equipment, inside drop ceilings and wall voids or anywhere ant problems occur. To apply baits to vertical surfaces use the enclosed stickers.

Do not use residual sprays with or near Volcano Ant Baits.

Ants will begin to die in 24 hours -- significant population reduction can be expected in about a week.

FOR EFFECTIVE CONTROL

Use 3 to 4 baits for the average size room. Use 6 to 8 baits for heavy infestations.

Bait stations are designed to be visually inspected with a flashlight. This allows for monitoring and timely replacement. Replacement is recommended after 3 months or when bait is almost entirely consumed (do not risk loss of control by allowing complete consumption).

Volcano Ant Baits are packaged in a Child-Resistant Container.
