Pecan	Scab, Brown Leaf Spot, Downy Spot, Powdery Mildew, Liver Spot, Sooty Mold, Leaf Blotch	5.0-7.5 (7.5-5.0 acres/2.34 lb pack or 1.5-1.0 acres/7.5 oz. pack or 5.0-3.3 acres/25 oz. pack)	Ground (Enclosed Cabs Only): Apply in sufficient water to provide for full coverage. Aerial: Apply in a minimum of 20 gallons of water. Diluted spray should be directed to all parts of the tree. Application should begin at prepollination stages when young leaves are unfolding, and a second application made when the small nuts are forming. Apply a maximum of nine treatments during a single growing season at 2 to 4 week intervals as needed to maintain control. Use the lower rate for the first two applications or until the disease becomes severe or during dry weather. Use the higher rate during wet weather or during severe scab, powdery mildew or other disease infections. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest. Apply a maximum seasonal use rate of 30 ounces of Super Tin 80WP for pecans grown west of Interstate 35. Apply a maximum seasonal use rate of 45 ounces of Super Tin 80WP for pecans grown east of Interstate 35.

Use intact water soluble packages of Super Tin. During agitation, add the package(s) of Super Tin and sufficient Dodine 65WP to maintain a ratio of 3.75 ounces of Super Tin to 16 ounces of Dodine 65WP per acre treated. Apply at 10 to 21 day intervals across the growing season to control scab. Ground (Enclosed Cabs Only): Apply in sufficient water to provide for full coverage. Aerial: Apply in a minimum of 20 gallons of water. Diluted spray should be directed to all parts of the tree. Observe all label prohibitions concerning tankmixing of Super Tin and Dodine with other materials. Do not apply after shucks have started to open or within 30 days of harvest, whichever occurs first. Apply a maximum seasonal use rate of 30 ounces of Super Tin 80WP for pecans grown west of Interstate 35. Apply a maximum seasonal use rate of 45 ounces of Super Tin 80WP for pecans grown east of Interstate 35.
