e. Delete the phrase "or as bait is consumed and effectiveness diminishes." in item 6 of the directions for use.


f. Move the statement "DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN OR PETS TO PLAY WITH THE BAITs" above the signal word CAUTION.

1. Remove all 12 bait stations from the plastic frame.
2. Place at least 10 baits in the kitchen and 2 in each bathroom. For LARGER KITCHENS OR PARTICULARLY HEAVY INFESTATIONS, use additional baits and place 12 - 15 stations in the kitchen and 2 - 4 in each bathroom. Always place stations where you have seen roaches. If you see roaches in other areas such as the bedroom or utility room, use additional baits.
3. For best results, place the baits next to the wall along baseboards, in corners, under sinks, in cabinets and near plumbing fixtures. You can even place **Indoor Roach Bait**s on kitchen countertops and next to food.
4. Baits work best on horizontal surfaces touching corners and walls. To place stations on vertical surfaces, use the enclosed stickers.
5. Roaches will begin eating the baits immediately, and you should expect to see fewer roaches within days.
