1. Remove all 12 bait stations from the plastic frame. *[Additional new smaller package size says "6 bait stations."]*
2. Place at least 10 baits in the kitchens and 2 in each bathroom. For LARGER KITCHENS OR PARTICULARLY HEAVY INFESTATIONS, use additional baits and place 12 – 15 stations in the kitchen and 2 – 4 in each bathroom. Always place stations where you have seen roaches. If you see roaches in other areas such as the bedroom or utility room, use additional baits.
