Do not apply more than 5 pounds active ingredient per acre per year.

1998 Calendar Year

Do not apply more than 3.0 pounds of active ingredient per acre per year. An enclosed cab is required when applying this product. An enclosed cab must have a nonporous barrier that totally surrounds the occupants and prevents contact with pesticides outside the cab.

1999-2002 Calendar Years

Do not apply more than 1.0 pound active ingredient per acre per year. An enclosed cab is required when applying this product. This product cannot be sold or distributed after September 30, 2002 and cannot be used after December 31, 2002.
