

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Description: Noah Gold CS is a water-dilutable preservative concentrate used to protect wood against decay (soft rot, brown rot and white rot), termite attack, and staining fungi (blue stain).

Product Uses: For application by pressure treatment to lumber, timbers, shingles and shakes, siding, plywood, and engineered wood composites used in above ground and below ground applications. Do not use on wood that will come in direct contact with food.

Wood Preparation: Machine, cut, glue, and sand wood as desired before treating. Do not use over previously finished or stained wood without stripping off old finish. Wood must be clean and dry before treatment. Wood should be kiln dried or air seasoned to a moisture content of about 25% or less which will permit adequate penetration of preservative during treatment.

Dilution of Concentrate: Dilute Noah Gold CS concentrate with water to provide a working Ready-To-Use (RTU) solution (4 to 46 gallons of Noah Gold CS per 1,000 gallons of RTU solution). Dilution rate is dependent upon wood species, method of application and the intended use of the treated wood product.

Treatment: Apply RTU dilution by pressure treatment processes (double vacuum, full-cell or modified full-cell). All treated wood must be held on the drip pad until drippage has stopped. Surfaces cut after first treatment may be retreated using brush-applied Noah Gold CS concentrate full strength.

Clean-up: Use soap and water to remove wet Noah Gold CS wood preservative from all surfaces, brushes and rollers. Dispose of cleaning waste in accordance with local, state, and Federal regulations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place. Combustible. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store above freezing and below 104°F (40°C).

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
