
ANTIDOTES

EXTERNAL Wipe off acid gently
immediately. Flood the surface with
water, using soap freely. Then cover
with moist magnesia or baking soda
slices. Flush thoroughly with water.
Call physician immediately.

INTERNAL Call a physician im-
mediately. Drink teaspoonful mag-
nesia chalk, whiting or wall plaster
or small pieces of soap softened
water in milk or raw egg white.

**TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT
TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS.**

Force water from bowl over the
trap with a small bowl mop. Pour
10 oz. of cleaner on a bowl mop or
brush held over the bowl. Rub bowl
and under rim to remove discolora-
tions. Allow to stand for 2 to 3
minutes. For bad discoloration re-
peat above, and allow to remain 15
minutes before flushing.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE FOR
CLEANING THE INVISIBLE
TRAP OR OUTLET IN URINAL:**

Remove the drain plate. Place a
bowl mop into the drain, and pour
a 1/2 pint of fluid onto the mop.
Allow to remain for 2 to 3 minutes
until reaction is completed, then
work mop up and down until scale
is removed then flush toilet.
