

DIRECTIONS

TOILET BOWLS (white or colored) Remove water from Toilet Bowl by forcing through trap. Then pour 1/4 cup around sides of bowl and a small amount on the brush to clean under the rim. Brush out bowl immediately. If bowls are badly discolored with lime and rust, pour in 1 cup of bowl cleaner and brush thoroughly.

FLUSHING TANK Turn off water. Flush tank empty. Pour a small amount of bowl cleaner on brush to clean tank.

CERAMIC TILE AND GLASS (Wear rubber gloves) Dampen cloth with bowl cleaner, wipe off discoloration. Wash with soap and water. Do a small area at a time. Always test a small area first.

DANGER: Contains hydrochloric acid. **CORROSIVE:** May be fatal if swallowed. Produces chemical burns. Do not swallow, keep away from eyes, skin, clothing. Don't breathe vapor or fumes. Do not use on bath tubs, wash bowls, chrome or other enameled surfaces, or set bottle on these fixtures. Do not mix with cleaners, bleaches or other chemicals.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

ANTIDOTES

EXTERNAL—Skin—Wipe off acid gently. Immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely. Then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda. **Eyes—**flush thorough with water—call physician immediately.

INTERNAL—Drink teaspoonful magnesia, chalk, whiting or wall plaster, or small pieces of soap softened with water in milk or raw egg white. Call a physician.
