CONTINUATION OF DIRECTIONS FOR USE

centrate to four parts of water. Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

To kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Throughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.


