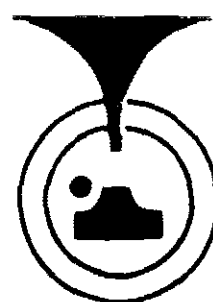

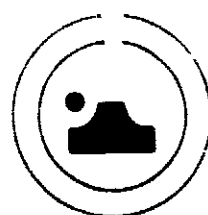

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children.
Corrosive. Causes severe eye
and skin damage. Do not get in
eyes, on skin or on clothing.
Wear goggles or face shield
and rubber gloves when hand-

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately
flush eyes or skin with plenty
of water for at least 15 minutes.
For eyes, call a physician. Re-
move and wash contaminated
clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a
large quantity of milk, egg
whites, gelatin solution or if
these are not available, drink
large quantities of water. Avoid
alcohol. Call a physician im-
mediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may
contraindicate the use of gas-
tric lavage. Measures against
circulatory shock as well as
oxygen and measures to sup-
port breathing manually or
mechanically may be needed.
If persistent, convulsions may
be controlled by the cautious
intravenous injection of a short-
acting barbiturate drug.
