Application	Dilution rates to make Pace T-20-XX Use-Solution
Disinfection:	Add 4.5 oz. Pace T-20-XX per gallon water
Sanitization:	Add 8.0 oz. Pace T-20-XX per 5 gallons water
Mold & Mildewstat:	Add 4.5 oz. Pace T-20-XX per gallon water

GENERAL DISINFECTION - For disinfection of inanimate hard surfaces:

- Apply use-solution of 4.5 oz. PACE T-20-XX per gal water with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.
- Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes.
- Prepare a fresh use-solution for each treatment.

SANITIZATION - For sanitization of previously cleaned and rinsed nonporous food contact surfaces:

- Prepare a 200 ppm active quaternary use-solution; 8 oz. PACE T-20-XX per 5 gal water.
- Flood the area with use-solution or apply with a cloth or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds.
- Let air dry.
- Prepare a fresh use-solution for each treatment.
- At this level (200 ppm quat) no potable water rinse is required.

MOLD & MILDEWSTAT - For control of mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard, nonporous surfaces:

- Apply use-solution of 4.5 oz. PACE T-20-XX per gal water with a cloth, mop, or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely.
- Let air dry.
- Prepare a fresh use-solution for each treatment.
- Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth appears.
