When used as directed, this product is formulated to disinfect hard, non-porous, inanimate, environmental surfaces: floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, glazed porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, bathrooms, shower stalls, bathtubs, cabinets, tables, chairs (non-upholstered surfaces), and telephones.
