A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.



BTC-2125M-P40 in recommended use dilutions is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces. **DO NOT MIX WITH SOAP OR OTHER ANIONIC MATERIALS.**

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER-CORROSIVE
KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
