Proposed Amendment

Update label Language in response to PR Notice 2001-1 (First Aid Statements)

Label Comments

- 1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read: "DANGER, Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed. Maybe fatal if inhaled. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Wear a dust/mist filtering respirator (MHSA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C), or a NIOSH approved respirator with any N, R, P or HE filter. Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."
- Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement to include: "Containers 1 gallon or less store in original container in a locked storage area in accessible to persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in the trash."
