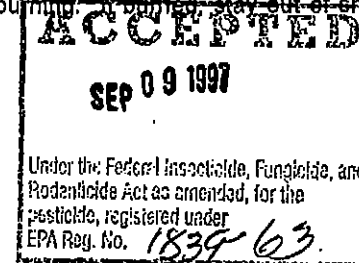
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
