DANGER

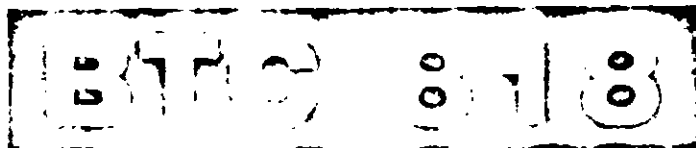
FIRST AID
