

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Onyx NP 12.5 Detergent/disinfectant has been designed specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants, food service establishments and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.

Disinfection - To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops), add 1/2 ounce NP 12.5 detergent/disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet, add 1/2 ounce NP 12.5 detergent/disinfectant directly to the bowl water. Swab the bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush.

For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required and recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops) add 1/2 ounce NP 12.5 per gallon of water. Apply solution with a cloth, mop, or sponge making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

SANITIZATION - To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200ppm active quaternary NP 12.5 solution by adding 1 ounce to 5 gallons of water.

To sanitize immobile items (such as tables, crapping blocks, counter tops), flood the area with 200ppm NP 12.5 solution or apply with a cloth or sponge, making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

To sanitize mobile items (such as drinking glasses, eating utensils), immerse in 200ppm NP 12.5 solution for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Remove and let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently if mold is apparent.

DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may indicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against convulsory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.

NET CONTENTS

ONYX NP 12.5 is a phosphate free concentrated detergent/disinfectant which provides effective cleaning, deodorizing, disinfection, and sanitization. Onyx NP 12.5 Detergent/disinfectant has been designed specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross contamination.

NP 12.5 when diluted at the rate of 1/2 ounce per gallon of water is an effective disinfectant against the organism *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and meets all requirements for hospital use. When used as directed, Onyx NP 12.5 is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces such as walls, floors, sink tops, toilet bowls, tables, chairs, telephones and bed frames. For larger areas such as operating rooms, patient care facilities and restrooms, the product is designed to provide both general cleaning and disinfection.

In addition, Onyx NP 12.5 deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, toilet bowls and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

Disinfection - At 1/2 ounce per gallon dilution, Onyx NP 12.5 exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the following:

At this level the product is also fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.

Virucidal* Activity: The product when used on environmental inanimate hard surfaces at 1/2 ounce per gallon of water exhibits effective virucidal* activity against Influenza A₁ - Asian (representative of the common flu virus), Herpes simplex (causative agent of fever blisters and mononucleosis), Adeno virus type 5 (causative agent of upper respiratory infections), and Vaccinia virus (representative of the pox virus group).

Efficacy tests have demonstrated that NP 12.5 is an effective bactericide, fungicide, and virucide* in the presence of organic soil (1% blood serum).

Mold and Mildewstat - Onyx NP 12.5 prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

Sanitization - When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment or food contact items limit active quaternaries to 200ppm. At this level NO HOT WATER RINSE is required.

NP 12.5 is an effective sanitizer when diluted in water up to 600ppm hardness (CaCO₃).
