



### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

#### General Classifications

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

#### Directions for Use in Swimming Pools

**Initial Dose:** Add 1 quart of 10% BTC 2125M swimming pool algacide to 50,000 gallons of pool water.

**Maintenance Dose:** Add 1 quart of 10% BTC 2125M swimming pool algacide to 50,000 gallons of pool water.

Initial dose is used when the pool is first opened for the swimming season. If pool has visible algae with the water, add 1 quart of 10% BTC 2125M swimming pool algacide to 50,000 gallons of pool water. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae. If algae are still present or reappear, repeat the treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of 10% BTC 2125M for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make up water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 1 quart of 10% BTC 2125M to 50,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

When 10% BTC 2125M is used as directed it will help prevent development of *Chlorella pyrenoidosa* (green), *Enteromorpha* (black algae), *Phormidium retzii* (square), *Scenedesmus* (blue-green) and other swimming pool algae.

10% BTC 2125M is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with other water-treating chemicals. 10% BTC 2125M will not react when added by itself directly to pool water. 10% BTC 2125M use dilution is non-corrosive to masonry surfaces.

#### Directions For Use in Spas/Whirlpools/Hot Tub Baths

**Initial Dose:** Add 12.8 ounces of 10% BTC 2125M swimming pool algacide per 5,000 gallons of water. Initial dose is used at filling of Spa/Whirlpool/Hot Tub Bath.

**Maintenance Dose:** Add 3.2 ounces of 10% BTC 2125M Swimming Pool Algacide per 5,000 gallons of water. Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 days intervals. If high temperatures prevail or Spa/Whirlpool/Hot Tub Bath has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

Drain and clean Spas/Whirlpool/Tub Bath at least once a month or as needed depending on bather load.
