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## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Disinfectant Pump Spray is designed specifically for use in homes, nursing homes, schools and hotels as a disinfectant and deodorant. It is intended for use as a disinfectant for telephones, bed springs, door knobs, linen carts, hampers, wheel chairs, tables, cabinets, light switches, garbage pails, and other clean, inanimate, non-porous hard surfaces. In addition, Disinfectant Pump Spray deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, basements, restrooms, shower stalls, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms. Disinfectant Pump Spray can also be used as a room air deodorizer and refreshenar.

SURFACE DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION - For disinfection, first remove soil deposits from surface to be treated. Hold container six inches from surface and spray until completely wet, allowing the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

AIR DEODORIZER AND AIR REFRESHENER - Spray upwards to center of room for three (3) seconds.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard, non-porous surfaces spray surface to be treated making sure to wet completely. Lat air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth appears.


