The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Addition of optional refill container directions for use
- Addition of optional refill container disposal instructions

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Page two:

1. Qualify the surface "porcelain" by including the term glazed proceeding it to read "glazed porcelain."
2. Revise the "To disinfect food service establishment food contact surfaces" directions by including the statement "Do not use on eating utensils, glassware and cookware."

3. Revise the "If on skin or clothing" section to read:


If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin *immediately* with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Detergent Disinfectant Pump Spray is designed specifically as a general non-acid cleaner and disinfectant for use in homes, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants, food service establishments, transportation terminals, office buildings, manufacturing facilities, lodging establishments, retail businesses and athlete/recreational facilities where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross contamination. It is formulated to disinfect hard, non-porous, inanimate environmental surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, bathrooms, shower stalls, bathtubs, and cabinets. For plastic and painted surfaces, spot test on an inconspicuous area before use. May be used in the kitchen on counters, sinks, appliances, and stovetops. A rinse with potable water is required for surfaces in direct contact with food. In addition, this product deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, basements, restrooms and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high-level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body.

Optional Directions for Product Supplied in Refill Bottles

Fill or refill the X ozs. Detergent Disinfectant Pump Spray spray bottle with the Detergent Disinfectant Pump Spray refill. Pour product into spray bottle over sink or tub basin.

DISINFECTION, DEODORIZING AND CLEANING - Remove gross filth or heavy soil prior to application of the product. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated. Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing is necessary. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum.

one-step cleaning and disinfection of toilet bowls and urinals: Remove water from bowl by forcing water over trap with a swab mop applicator. Press swab mop against side of the bowl to remove excess water from applicator. Apply 1 to 2 ounces of this product evenly, allowing sufficient time for product to cover entire surface of bowl for maximum cleaning. Swab bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand 10 minutes and flush.

To disinfect food processing premises: floors, walls and storage areas, hold container six to eight inches from the surface to be treated and spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge and thoroughly rinse all surfaces in the area with potable water. Heavily soiled areas must be pre-cleaned before using this product.

Food products and packaging materials must be removed or carefully protected prior to using this product.

To disinfect food service establishment food contact surfaces: countertops, appliances, tables, hold container six to eight inches from the surface to be treated and spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge and thoroughly rinse all surfaces in the area with potable water. Heavily soiled areas must be pre-cleaned before using this product.

TUBERCULOCIDAL ACTIVITY - This product exhibits disinfectant efficacy against Mycobacterium tuberculosis (BCG) in 10 minutes at 20 degrees Centigrade when used as directed on previously cleaned hard non-porous inanimate surfaces.

ACTERICIDAL ACTIVITY - When used as directed, this product exhibits effective disinfectant activity against the organisms: Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Escherichia coli 0157:H7, Methicillin resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA), Vancomycin intermediate resistant Staphylococcus aureus (VISA), Vancomycin resistant Enterococcus faecalis (VRE) and meets the requirements for hospital use.

***VIRUCIDAL ACTIVITY** - This product, when used on environmental, inanimate, non-porous surfaces, exhibits effective virucidal activity against HIV-1 (associated with AIDS), Canine Parvovirus, Poliovirus Type 1, Hepatitis B Virus (HBV) and Hepatitis C Virus (HCV).

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned, hard, non-porous surfaces spray surface to be treated making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth appears.

FUNGICIDAL ACTIVITY - This product is fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi, Trichophyton mentagrophytes (Athlete's Foot Fungus) when used as directed on hard surfaces found in bathrooms, shower stalls, locker rooms, or other clean, non-porous, hard surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet.

EFFICACY TESTS HAVE DEMONSTRATED THAT THIS PRODUCT IS AN EFFECTIVE BACTERICIDE, FUNGICIDE, AND VIRUCIDE IN THE PRESENCE OF ORGANIC SOIL (5% BLOOD SERUM).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
