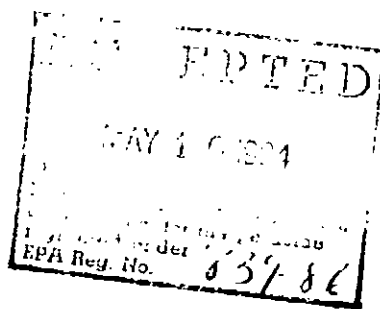
Disinfection of Poultry Equipment, Animal Quar-  
ters and Kennels.

Poultry brooders, watering founts, feeding equip-  
ment and other animal quarters (such as stalls  
and kennel areas) can be disinfected after thor-  
ough cleaning by applying a solution of 3.5 oz. to  
5 gallons of water. Small utensils should be  
immersed in this solution.

Prior to disinfection, all poultry, other animals  
and their feeds must be removed from the premises.  
This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other  
feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter  
and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces  
occupied or traversed by poultry or other animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings, coops, and  
other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, or other  
animals or employ equipment until treatment has been  
absorbed, set or dried.

All treated equipment that will contact feed or drink-  
ing water must be rinsed with potable water before  
reuse.
