

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Dose: add 1 gallon 5% BTC 776 swimming pool algaecide to 25,000 gallons of pool water.

Maintenance Dose: add 1 quart 5% BTC 776

swimming pool algaecide to 5,000 gallons of pool water.

Initial dose is used when filling pool at beginning of swimming season. If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If still algae are still present or reoccur, repeat the treatment procedure as noted on label. Once pool is free of visible algae, use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance dose should be added at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of 5% BTC 776 for each 5,000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week.

When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of 5% BTC 776 to 25,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool when it is returned to use the following season.

When 5% BTC 776 is used as directed, it will kill and prevent development of *Chlorocella cyrenoidosa* (Green), *Phormidium imbricatum* (Black algae), *Phormidium retzii* (Square Black algae), *Lyngbya versicolor* (Blue-Green) and other swimming pool algae.

5% BTC 776 is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other water-treating chemicals. 5% BTC 776 works best when added directly to pool water. Do not use if you are allergic to non-corrosive, non-toxic chemicals.

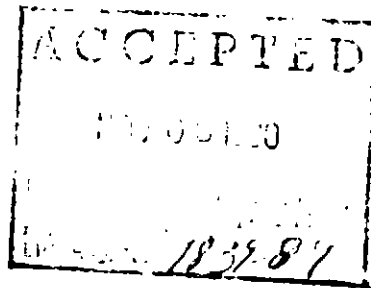
