algaeicide to 50,000 gallons of pool water

If make-up water is added at the rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity, add 1 quart of 10% NaOCl for each 1000 gallons of fresh make-up water added per week. When swimming season is over, add 1 gallon of 10% NaOCl to 2,000 gallons of water in treating water left in pool. This dose helps provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months. This treatment will also help the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following season.

10257299 is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other water-treating chemicals. 10257299 works best when added by itself directly to pool water. 10257299 at use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

Initial Dose: Add 2.5 ounces of 10% Bt-99 Swimming Pool Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Initial dose is used upon filling of Spa/Whirlpool/Hot Tub Bath.

Drain and clean Spa/Whirlpool/Hot Tub Bath at least once a month or as needed depending on bather load.*
