NP 5.5 HW (D&F) Detergent/Disinfectant is a phosphate-free formulation designed to provide effective cleaning, decidorizing, nonfood contact sanitizing, and disinfection specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, food processing plants, and other Institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross contamination.

NP 5.5 HW (D&F) Detergent/Disinfectant, when used as directed, is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces such as walls, floors, sink tops, toilet bowls, tables, chairs, telephones, and bedframes. For larger areas, such as operating rooms, patient care facilities, and restrooms, this product is designed to provide general cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing of non-food contact surfaces.
