The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.



Revise as follows: Under the Storage and Disposal (Containers greater than 5 gallons) delete "Empty the rinsate into the application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal" replace with "Follow Pesticide Disposal instructions for rinsate disposal.

Scented 10% BTC® 2125M Disinfectant is designed specifically for hospitals, animal quarters, kennels and institutions where disinfection and deodorization are of prime importance.

When used as directed, this product is formulated to disinfectant pre-cleaned inanimate, hard, non-porous surfaces: metal surfaces, stainless steel surfaces, glazed porcelain, glazed ceramic tile, plastic surfaces, bathrooms, shower stalls, bathtubs, toilets, cabinets, tables, chairs, walls, floors and bed frames.

This product deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, pet areas and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.


DILUTION RATES:

GENERAL DISINFECTION - Add 3 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water for disinfection against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Listeria monocytogenes, and Yersinia enterocolitica. HOSPITAL DISINFECTION - Add 3.5 ounces of this product per 5 gallons of water for disinfection against Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

Empty the rinsate into the application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.
