DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Triangle Pine Beetle Spray is a concentrated insecticide miscible with either water or fuel oil for use in controlling the turpentine bark beetle on live trees. One quart contains 0.25 pounds of Lindane and is sufficient for treating 20 average sized trees, (8 to 10 inch trunks). Fuel oil is slightly more effective as a diluent but may damage lawns, in which case water should be used as a diluent.

This is a concentrated insecticide and must be diluted for use. Mix 1 part of concentrate with 11 parts of water or fuel oil for use. Wet trunks of trees thoroughly with drenching spray, to a height of about 15 feet above the ground, or at least above pitch tubes. For LP S Beetles, trunk should be sprayed up to top. Trees are to be sprayed preferably in May or June, or whenever infestation is noted. Repeat each spring and through summer if necessary.
