

# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** **For Professional Use Only**

This is a concentrated insecticide for the prevention and control of subterranean termites in new construction and existing buildings. This is a concentrated insecticide and must be diluted for use. Make a standard solution by diluting 1 lb. Dieldrin with water as follows:

Solution A: Use 1 gallon of 1 lb. Dieldrin to 4 gallons of water.

## **DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION**

### **A. BUILDING WITH CRAWL SPACES**

(1) Apply 2 gallons standard solution per linear feet to critical areas only under the foundation, such as along the inside of foundation walls, around piers, sewer pipes, conduits, etc. Trench according to directions in part (2) below.

(2) Along the outside and outside of foundation walls, dig a narrow trench, such trench to be dug no deeper than the top of the footing. If the trench is less than 15 inches in depth to the top of the footing, apply 1 gallon standard solution per 5 linear feet. Replace the soil and apply another 1 gallon standard solution per 5 linear feet to the back fill. Cover the back fill with a layer of soil. If the trench is more than 15 inches in depth to the top of the footing, apply 2 gallons of standard solution per 5 linear feet. Replace the soil and apply another 2 gallons standard solution per 5 linear feet to the back fill. Cover the back fill with a layer of soil. A trench 30 inches deep is a maximum depth required alongside those foundations where the top of the footings is greater than 30 inches deep.

(3) Apply 1 gallon standard solution per 10 square feet of soil surface under attached porch entrance platform utility entrances and similar situations where slab or fill is at the grade level. Where crawl spaces exist, treat as described in part (1) above.

### **(B) BUILDINGS WITH CONCRETE SLAB ON THE GROUND**

(1) Apply 1 gallon standard solution per 10 square feet, as an over all treatment under the slab as well as under attached porches, entrance platforms, utility entrances and similar situations where slab or fill is at grade level.

(2) Apply 2 gallons standard solution per 5 linear feet to critical areas only under the slab, such as along the inside of foundation walls, around sewer pipes, and conduits. Trench as in part (3) below.

Along the outside and inside of foundation walls, dig a narrow trench with a maximum width of 15 inches and deeper than the top of the footing. If the trench is deeper than 15 inches, apply 2 gallons standard solution per 5 linear feet. Replace the soil and apply another 2 gallons standard solution per 5 linear feet to the back fill. Cover the back fill with a layer of soil.

### **C. BUILDINGS WITH BASEMENTS**

Apply 2 gallons standard solution per 10 square feet of basement floor. Where crawl spaces exist, treat as described in part A above.

### **WARNING**
