FOR MOST COMPLETE PROTECTION from many common garden cultural, truck crop and ornamental plants, apply as soon as injurious insects appear, and repeat treatments against reinfestations or migrations.

Apply the dust for complete coverage, with special attention to the underside of the leaf, and other parts commonly attacked by insects.

This material can be applied with a power duster. When plants are small, from 1/4 to 1/2 pound of dust per 100 sq. ft. On mature plants, and when plants are closed, apply at the rate of 1/2 pound necessary adequate coverage.
