BREATH DUST, VAP-Y MIST. Wear a mask or respirator of type passed by U. S. Department of Agriculture for Parathion protection. Airplane pilots should wear full face canister type mask.

If handled indoors provide mechanical exhaust ventilation.

DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOOD OR FEED PRODUCTS. Bury spillage. Clean up area with strong lye solution. Burn or bury containers. Never re-use. Stay out of smoke or fumes.

#### PHYSICIANS NOTE

Warning symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurring vision, nonreactive pin point pupils, salivating, sweating, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps.

by injection, Grain 1/100, two or three tablets at once, and parenterally or orally every hour as required up to 30 tablets or until pupils dilate. Never give morphine. Clear thest by postural drainage. Artificial respiration or oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously 48 hours. Repeated exposure to cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood tests.

Atropine is an antidote. Consult physician for emergency supply.

#### **ANTIDOTE**

Call a physician at once in all cases of suspected Parathion poisoning. If symptoms or signs of poisoning include blurred vision, abdominal cramps and tightness of chest don't wait for a doctor but give two atropine tablets (each 1/100 gr.) at once. Remove patient immediately from area where Parathion is present. Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin clean with plenty of soap and water, to remove all traces of Parathion. If swallowed, induce vomiting by giving warm salty or soapy water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not give liquids to unconscious patient. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.
